

We look forward to welcoming you at Mount Gould Hospital. There are a number of entrances into the site and our map is designed to help you find the one that is most suitable for your visit.

If you are coming by car, please use the designated parking spaces around the site. As well as limited parking near many of the buildings there are also drop-off points and parking reserved for visitors and patients beneath and behind the Local Care Centre (using entrance 2). The Local Care Centre and Primary Care Centre both have lower ground floor entrances with stairway or lift access to reception areas. Entrances to all of the buildings are clearly marked and there are a number of spaces reserved for Disabled Parking throughout the site.

Mount Gould Hospital is divided into five colour and symbol coded zones to enable you to find your way around and identify different buildings on the site. There are signs and display copies of our map throughout the site.

The purpose of this map and the signs on site is to direct you to a building by its name. Your appointment letter should advise you of the service or department your appointment is with within a specified building. Please refer to your appointment letter and remember to bring it with you.

A café and toilets are available in the Local Care Centre reception area.

Weekend Appointments or Visits

The main reception entrance of the Local Care Centre building (from Mount Gould Road) is closed at the weekends. Access for appointments within the Local Care Centre are available via the Kingfisher and Skylark Wards building entrance. This entrance is near the lower ground floor parking area of the Local Care Centre.



Getting There

Car

The area of Mount Gould is within easy bus and walking distance from Plymouth City Centre and is also accessible from the Embankment Road turn-off, if coming in via the A38.

Bus

Mount Gould is accessed by both Citybus and First. Full details of all buses, along with their timetables, can be found in the Plymouth Transport Guide as produced by Plymouth City Council.

Parking

There are parking facilities both within the Mount Gould Hospital site and the Local Care Centre. Parking is free to all patients and visitors.
