Feeling Safer- Persecutory delusions are very common in mental health conditions such as schizophrenia. 'Feeling Safe' was previously tested in a clinical trial with 130 patients with persistent persecutory delusions. The treatment was delivered by clinical psychologists over 20 sessions. This study has now created a six-month guided online version. A range of mental health workers can support the delivery of the treatment.
